

# Krekoski wins silver medal

The BEL Boxing Club of Bridgenorth had four boxers compete in the 2005 junior and senior open provincial championships in Sarnia over the weekend.

Lita Mae Button, competing in the 70-kilogram senior female division, was awarded a berth on the Ontario team and advances to the national championships in St. Catharines Jan. 6-8 by way of walkover. Her opponent Aimee Willimot of the KAYO Boxing Club of Toronto failed to make her weight class on the day of the competition and was disqualified.

Ontario novice champion in the 69kg class, Cody Davis, competed in his first bout at open class with 11 bouts. He met Jerome Gabriel (55 bouts) of the Motor City Boxing

Club of Oshawa. Gabriel outpointed Davis in the third round of the four-round bout.

Luke Fuderer, with 18 bouts and fighting in the 75 kg division picked up a bronze medal against Richard Reittie (66 bouts) of Sully's Boxing Club, Toronto. Reittie won on points and later won gold.

Erin Krekoski, boxing in the female open 66kg division picked up a silver medal against Amanda Beaulieu of Tillers Boxing Club in Ajax. Krekoski was upgraded from novice to open class with only eight bouts to compete against Beaulieu with 37 bouts. The whistle blew in the third round because of a large point spread and Beaulieu was awarded the gold.
